

## **Student Activity Fee**

All high school and junior high students participating in extra-curricular activities or a designated co-curricular activity will be required to pay an activity fee for each season of a sport as directed by the Board of Education each school year. The fee applies to any IHSA, IESA, Three Rivers Conference (TRAC) or Prairieland Conference sponsored activities that are not tied to the curriculum. The fee will be paid within 10 calendar days from the first day of practice or the student will be removed from participation until the fee has been paid. If a student is cut from a team after the fee has been paid, and they do not participate in another activity covered by the fee during the remainder of the school year, the fee will be reimbursed at the end of the school year, upon request. If a student quits a team or is removed from a team due to academic ineligibility or code of conduct violations, the fee will not be reimbursed. If a family is approved for fee waivers, the athletic fee will be also waived. The activity fee for 2023-2024 will be \$50 per student per sport, capping at \$100 per student and capping at \$200 per family.
