Assessment Information:

Students enrolled in AP classes will be taking the <u>AP Exams in May</u>. Parents/ Guardians and students should have received a letter in the mail with important information about test day. A permission slip was enclosed with this letter. Please have your student return the permission slip as soon as possible. Any questions, email Mrs. Drish (<u>drishju@sherrard.us</u>).

Senior Parents:

FAFSA:

Reminder that the FAFSA is required by the State of Illinois. Anyone who hasn't completed the FAFSA will be receiving a letter that includes a Non-Participation form. This form needs to be completed and returned to the counseling office if you plan on NOT completing the FAFSA.

If your student plans on attending college or a trade school, FAFSA is the form you need to complete in order to access federal grants, loans, and work-study funds.

NINTH GRADE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS for SCHOOL YEAR 24-25

- All ninth grade students are required to have an updated school physical.
- State law requires Illinois Department of Public Health form to be used.
- Physical forms are available at the school and on the school district web site www.sherrard.us, go to **Departments** and select **Health Services**, **Health Forms** and **Student Physical Form**.
- Physicals must be completed and signed by a physician licensed to practice medicine, a
 physician's assistant, or an advanced practice nurse. Chiropractors MAY NOT
 perform school or sports physicals.
- Parents or guardians are required by state law to complete and sign the **health history** portion on the back of the physical form.
- Sports physicals will not fulfill this requirement. The ninth-grade physical may be used for a sport physical for 395 days from the date of the exam. Students who receive freshman physicals March 1, 2024 will need another sports physical by April 1 of 2025, if they desire to participate in spring sports. Please keep this in mind when scheduling your child's physical.
- Call for vaccine and physical appointments prior to end of this school year.
- A copy of your child's immunization record may be required by the health care provider.
- STUDENTS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH PHYSICAL AND IMMUNIZATIONS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL PER STATE REQUIREMENTS. Completed physicals must be turned in by 10/15/24 or students will be excluded until physicals are completed.

Dental
Requirement

All 9th grade students must have a current dental exam dated after 11/15/23 or waiver completed by May 15, 2025. Forms are available on the district web

site, select Departments, Health Services, and Health Forms.

Health Requirement information and physical forms were given to parents at the registration meeting on Jan. 25, 2024. The remaining forms were given to the students whose parents were not in attendance at the meeting. Please contact the school nurse if you did not receive this information.

DENTAL REQUIREMENT FOR CURRENT 9TH GRADE STUDENTS Dental Exams due May 15, 2024



The State of Illinois requires dental exams for all **9**th **grade students**. Students currently in **9**th **grade** are required to have a completed dental exam or waiver on file by **May 15, 2024**.

- School dental exams must have been completed after **November 15, 2022**.
- The IDPH dental exam form must be used.
- Exams must be performed by licensed dentists.
- Dental waivers are allowed if:
 - Student is enrolled in free and reduced lunch program and does not have dental insurance.
 - Student is enrolled in free and reduced lunch program and is ineligible for public insurance (Medicaid/All Kids).
 - Student is enrolled in Medicaid/All Kids, but the family is unable to find a dentist or dental clinic in the community who will accept Medicaid/All Kids.
 - Student does not have any type of dental insurance and there is no low-cost dental clinics in the community that will see the child.
- Religious exemption is allowed if religious exemption form is completed.
- Dental appointment cards are accepted as long as the appointment is scheduled within 60 days of May 15. Completed dental exams must be turned in by the beginning of the following school year.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The State of Illinois requires all students entering the 12th grade for the 2024-2025 school year to provide proof of having received the meningitis vaccine (also known as Menveo, Menactra, Menquadfi) on or after their 16th birthday.

***NOTE: This must be the Meningococcal vaccine (Menactra, Menveo MenQuadfi). The Meningitis B Vaccine otherwise known as Trumenba or Bexsero **does not** meet this requirement. Some pharmacies such as Walgreens have administered the Meningitis B vaccine instead of the Meningococcal Vaccine.

STUDENTS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL ACCORDING TO SCHOOL CODE AND DISTRICT POLICY. Please provide verification of vaccines by the first day of school. Students not in compliance by October 15, 2024 will be excluded until requirements are met.

Your child's immunization record has been included with the needed vaccine listed.

Students may receive their immunization from their health care provider. Vaccines are also available at Mercer County Health Department in Aledo 582-3762, Rock Island County Health Department in Rock Island 793-1955, School Health Link in Moline 743-1470 and Walgreens. You will need to make an appointment and inquire about insurance and cost.
