

## Sherrard High School Schedule Change Policy

Schedule changes will be granted on rare occasions and must fit the following criteria:

- 1. Student did not fulfill a prerequisite and is not eligible for a current class.
- 2. Student needs a specific class to stay on track for graduation.
- 3. Student needs a specific class in order to be accepted to a certain college or university (seniors only).
- 4. Case manager request (special education).
- 5. Teacher recommendation based on performance in class.
- 6. Approval of the school principal or academic counselor.

Schedule changes will NOT be made for the following reasons:

- Student is in a sport/activity and leaves early. (study hall request for 8th hour)
- Student wants to be in a different section or with a different teacher.
- Class has too much work.

Moving from honors to regular or vise versa is a *teacher recommendation*. Same would apply when moving from a regular to a lower level course.

Students will be allowed <u>five (5) days (full school days)</u> in which to make changes to their schedule. During those five days, students will be <u>required</u> to complete a **Student Schedule Change** form and return it to Mrs. Drish before any change will be made.

If a student withdraws after the fifth day, his/her grade will be recorded as a WP (withdraw pass) or WF (withdraw fail) and recorded on their transcript as such.
